Application Procedure

Nominated students will be contacted by the International Mobility Office to fill in an online application, and send scanned copies of the following documents to exchange.fgses@um6p.ma:

- A recent photograph;
- Copy of passport;
- Up-to-date academic transcript;
- Provisional Learning Agreement;
- Health Insurance.

Once application forms are processed and reviewed, accepted incoming students will receive by mid-June, an acceptance email together with a practical information sheet.

Academics

- Incoming exchange students are eligible for all undergraduate and graduate level FGSES courses as long as they fulfill the required prerequisites.
- The FGSES adopts the ECTS credit scheme (1 credit=25 hours of study).
- Incoming exchange students are entitled to enroll up to 35 ECTS credits per semester. Each module listed in the course catalog (accessible at <u>www.fgses-um6p.ma/courselist</u>), including the Language course offerings (Moroccan Dialect (Darija), Arabic, French, Spanish, German, and Mandarin), carries a credit value of 5 ECTS.
- Languages of instruction are English, French & Arabic.
- No official language document is required: Incoming students are recommended to have at least B2 level in English and/or French.

On-site facilities

The FGSES/UM6P Rabat campus has modern facilities including connected-teaching blocs, library, catering, accommodation, a sport center and a swimming pool.



Accommodation

Incoming students can opt for various options of on-campus accommodation:

Individual room

*Exchange students are assured on-campus housing, and the allocation of preferred single rooms is contingent upon availability and demand.

Nominated students will receive an email from exchange.fgses@um6p.ma to book their accommodation in due time, incoming students can also enjoy a relatively cheap cost of living on campus, with diverse catering offers.

Visa & Health Insurance

Incoming exchange students must hold a health insurance policy meeting the following requirements:

- It must cover expenses in the event of emergency treatments and/or urgent hospitalization.
- It must cover the entire duration of your stay in Morocco.
- it must guarantee the return to your home country in case of serious illness.

If not, international Students can arrange an insurance upon arrival at the UM6P Health Center at 1380 MAD (≈138 USD).

Visa Application: Incoming exchange students should apply for a study visa, depending on their country of origin.
